Bridging the Gap in Early Childhood Education

At **SOCI**, we believe every child deserves access to high-quality early education—the foundation for lifelong success. Thanks to the unwavering support of our donors, partners, and advocates, 2024 was a year of meaningful progress and transformative impact.



Empowering Children and Families

Because of supporters like you, this year:

- ✓ **80 children** and families received SOCI scholarships, ensuring access to full-day, year-round, high-quality early education that fosters learning, growth, and school readiness.
- ✓ Proficiency rates improved dramatically. Children enrolled in **SOCI**-supported programs increased from **16% per client upon entry to 55%** Kindergarten-ready by the end of the year.
- ✓ **130 additional children** gained access to early education through expanded partnerships and center capacity.

Real Change, Real Impact

These numbers represent more than just data—they reflect real lives being changed:

- ✓ Parents are building stable, secure futures, no longer limited by the cost or availability of childcare.
- ✓ Children are receiving the critical early learning experiences that set them on a path for academic and life success.
- ✓ Educators and centers are better equipped to deliver consistent, high-quality care through expanded resources and training.

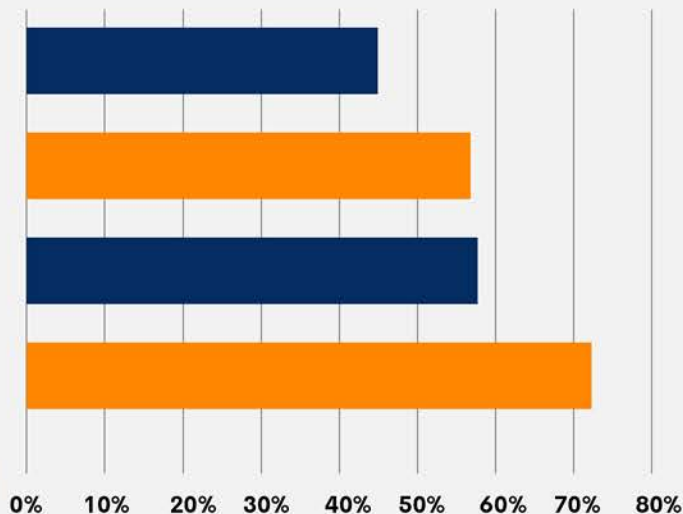

Note: Upon enrollment it is typical that 80% of the children enrolled are not Kindergarten-Ready.



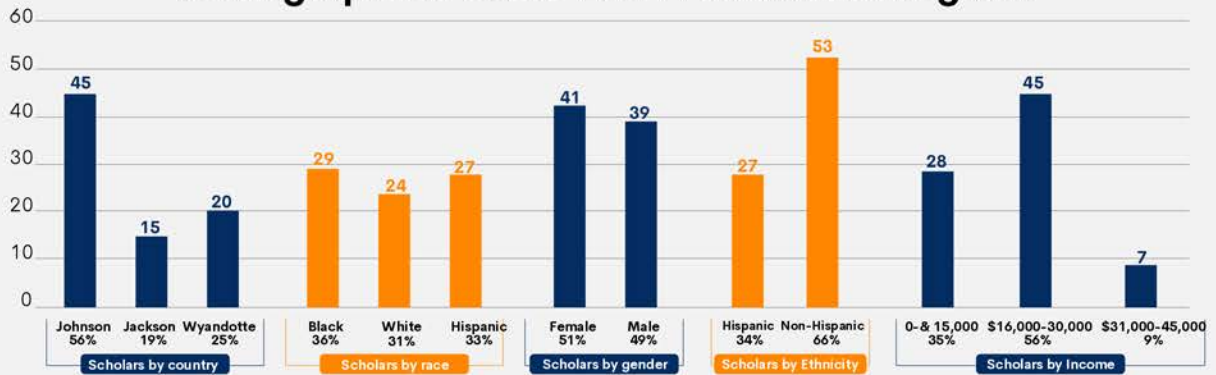
Looking Ahead: Expanding Our Reach in 2025

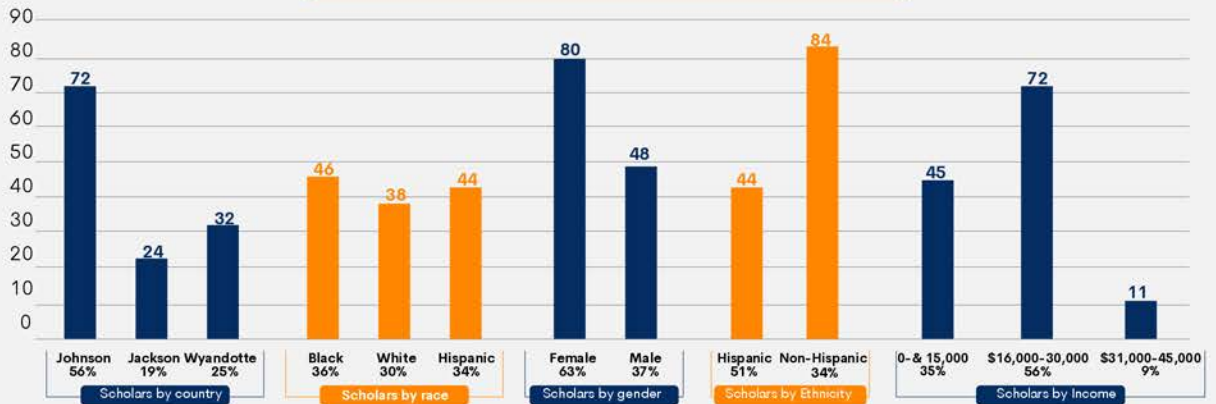
Demographics: 2023-2024 Academic Program

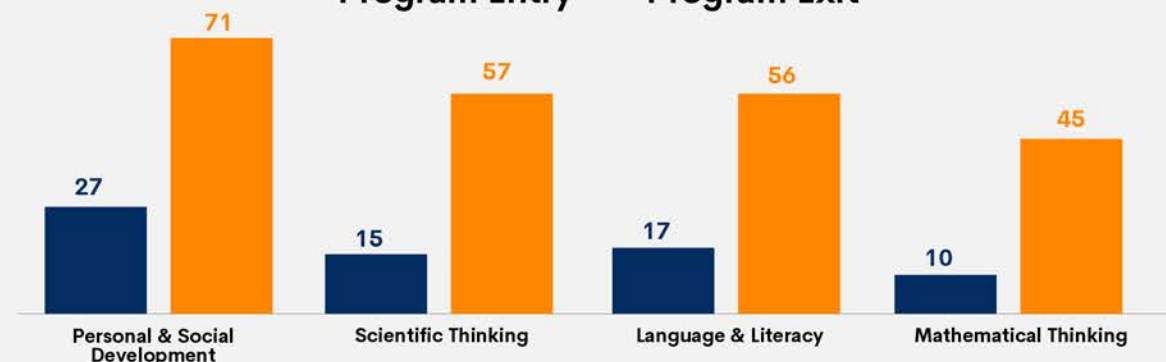
